Partnerships

We all know a team wins the game, not the player. The City of Laurinburg is fortunate to partner with numerous great organizations to accomplish a wide variety of tasks.

When it comes to economic and retail recruitment and development we rely on our partnership with Scotland County Economic Development Corporation (SCEDC). Through the efforts of this partnership many accomplishments have occurred the past year that have a tremendous impact on our community. Some of these include:

- ◆ Purchased and repaired the former Treasure City Pawn Shop in hopes of attracting another retail establishment to our historic downtown. Several drawings were reviewed and a final design has been approved.

- ◆ The 1st incubator building of the Scotland Incubator Park on HWY 401 has been constructed and leased to Carmichael Farms with the plans to hire 50 employees and invest \$25M. This is the 1st major industry announcement in the City since 2013 (FCC). Plans are to construct another building in the park by the May of 2020.
- ◆ Purchased the old Creech Hardware (102 Main Street) and have awarded the contract to begin roof repairs. The SCEDC will market this as a co-location space where multiple business can use the space.

Great partnerships produce great results and I think that's exactly what we are seeing!

Proper Disposal of Yard Debris

With these beautiful sunny days ahead, you may be making a decision to get out and do some landscaping on your property. Here are a few things to remember so you don't get surprised with an unexpected cost.

1. The City crews will pick up any grass clippings, leaves, and limbs from tree trimmings. Place these items beside the road, NOT in the road for pick up.
2. Do not place items on top of your water meter, sewer clean out, or near the storm drains. We use our claw trucks to pick up these items and placing debris near these items can cause damage.
3. The City does not pick up any limbs, logs, stumps, or mulch from tree removal. Home-owners are responsible for disposing of this debris themselves. If you plan to hire a contractor, please make sure that he/she is planning to remove the entire tree so that you don't get billed for the removal by the city crew.

Bi-Weekly Recycling Schedule

2019 - 2020



The City of Laurinburg collects residential curbside recyclable materials on a bi-weekly collection schedule. Each residence is assigned to either the **GREEN** or **RED** recycling route. This determines which week recyclables are collected according to the schedule below.

The recyclables will still be collected on the same day of the week as garbage. For example, if garbage collection day is on Monday, then recyclables collection will be every other Monday.

The City of Laurinburg now collects all the following items in the curbside recycling program:

Newspaper; Aluminum Cans; Steel Cans; All plastic containers with #1 - #7 on bottom (does not include Styrofoam); Cardboard; Clear, Brown, and Green glass bottles; Used Motor Oil (secured in a plastic bottle with a tight cap and placed beside the recycling cart); Used Cooking Oil (secured in a plastic bottle with a tight cap and placed beside the recycling cart)

Other Solid Waste Collection Schedules:

Corrugated cardboard is collected every other week along with other recyclables. Please flatten your cardboard boxes and place inside or next to your recycling cart on your scheduled recycling collection day.

Yard Waste is collected as often as possible with a goal of one pickup per week. It is not assigned to any particular day as the trucks just get as far as they can each day. Please separate all yard waste into two separate piles, one containing limbs, shrubbery clippings, and/or pine cones, and the other containing leaves and/or grass clippings. The City does not pick up any limbs, logs, stumps, or mulch from tree removal.

Bulky Items are collected weekly on the same day of the week as household garbage. Please place your bulky items at the curb on the same day that you place your roll-out cart at the curb for collection. Bulky items includes all large trash items that can't fit in your cart, such as furniture, white goods (appliances), television sets, large toys such as bicycles and swing sets, lawn equipment, and used tires. The City does not collect building materials resulting from construction, demolition, remodeling, or repair work.

Bulky items may not be placed at the street more than 24 hours prior to your scheduled collection day.
