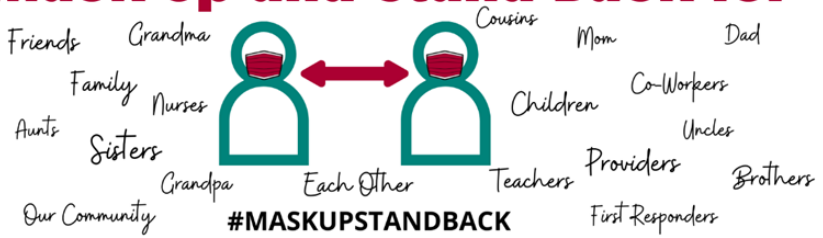
Message from the City Manager

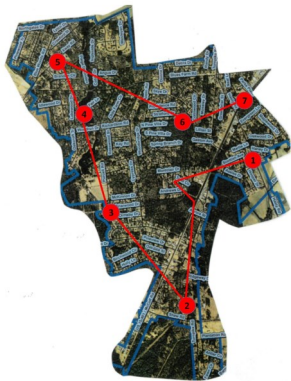
We are on Facebook...

Please take a few minutes and check out our “City of Laurinburg Government” facebook page. The City of Laurinburg Sanitation Department strives to keep you updated on where the leaf and limb trucks are on the route. We have taken to Facebook to help get the information out. The Sanitation Department plans to post at least once per week updating all customers on which portion and section we are on with both the leaf and limb trucks. Below is an example of how the post will be written.

WEEKLY LIMB/LEAF UPDATE: Our City Crews are currently on the **WEST** side of the City Limits at or around **Section # 4** collecting both leaves and limbs. When we finish the **WEST** side of the city limits we will head to the **NORTH** side. Our yard waste route starts on the South portion of the city limits, then moves to the West portion, then to the North portion and back around to the East portion. Once the East portion is complete, we immediately begin again on the South portion and continue the cycle.

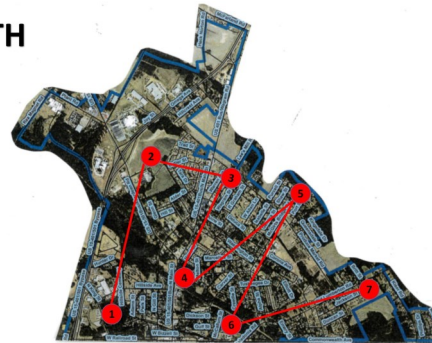
