Removal of Recycle Carts

Due to high contamination, recycling for our city residents will be on a voluntary basis only starting May 1, 2024. If you wish to recycle, the account holder will need to come to Public Works (503 Hall Street) before May 1st to sign an acknowledgement form. This person will be expected to recycle correctly and will be held responsible if there is ANY contamination found in the blue recycle cart. Holiday Schedule

The City of Laurinburg offices will be closed on Friday, March 29th, 2024 in observance of Good Friday. All solid waste routes for that Friday will be picked up on Thursday along with Thursday's route. The City of Laurinburg offices will also be closed on Monday, May 27th, 2024 in observance of Memorial Day. All solid waste routes for that Monday will be picked up on Tuesday along with the Tuesday route.

Removal of Recycle Carts Details

On May 1, 2024 city employees will begin removing recycle carts from all city residents who choose not to recycle. Residents who decide to keep their recycle carts and continue to recycle will need to come to Public Works before May 1st to sign a form stating they agree to follow our recycling guidelines and only place approved recyclable items in the cart. Please read the guidelines below for all approved recyclable items and if you decide you would like to keep your recycle cart, please have the account holder come to 503 Hall Street to sign the recycle cart acknowledgement form. DO NOT BAG YOUR ITEMS – NO BAGS ARE ALLOWED IN RECYCLE CARTS

ITEMS ALLOWED IN CARTS:

- 1. Plastic Bottles, tubs, jugs and jars (no pumps) with the #1 or #2 on the bottom. Please empty and rinse the bottles before placing in the cart.**
- 2. All Metal cans such as soda, dog food, soup cans, etc. Please empty and rinse.**
- 3. Clear, green or brown glass bottles. Please empty and rinse.**
- 4. Corrugated Cardboard Only such as Amazon boxes, TV Boxes or Moving Boxes**
- 5. Used motor oil or used cooking oil in a secure (1 gallon) container should be placed on the ground beside the Recycle Cart.**

ALL ITEMS NOT ON THIS LIST ABOVE ARE CONSIDERED GARBAGE AND SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE GREEN GARBAGE CART

Any recycling container containing garbage or non-recyclable items will be charged as follows:

1st Offense – Removal of Container and **\$350 fee** added to utility bill.

Customer must call Public Works in order to request that the cart be returned.

2nd Offense – Permanent Removal of Container with **\$350 fee** added to utility bill.
