Recycle Thank You!!!

As of June 15th, we have 561 households that have elected to continue receiving curbside recycling services and we have also noticed an increase in the use of our drop off center located off Hall Street. We are pleased to report that, because of these efforts, our contamination rate has gone from 80% to less than 5%. We understand this change wasn't an easy one, however the results speak for themselves. City residents now have the assurance that everything they place in the blue recycle carts will be taken to our recycle center and processed properly.

We would like to encourage more residents to come on board and recycle the proper way. If you

would like to join in this effort and sign up to receive curbside recycling, please come by our Public Works office at 503 Hall Street. There, you will receive guidance on what the City can accept in the blue carts and sign a form to have the cart delivered back to your home. We are extremely happy with the results after just over a month of the difficult changes and are excited about continuing the City's rich history and tradition in recycling. This would not be a success without the support of our citizens. Thank You!!!

Need an Extra Garbage Cart?

Recently, our bulky item trucks have been collecting extra bags of garbage that are placed beside the garbage carts. Our bulky item trucks should only be picking up large items that will not fit in your garbage cart such as furniture, TV's, appliances, large toys, etc.. Bags of garbage and other small garbage items should be placed inside the green garbage cart.

We do understand and expect that during holidays or special occasions residents may have extra bags of garbage to place beside the cart for pick up. However, if one green cart is not enough for your usual weekly garbage needs, you are eligible for an extra garbage cart. The extra cart can be delivered to you for a one-time rental fee of \$65. This rental fee is good for the life of the cart and your monthly service fee will not go up.

Bi-Weekly Recycling Schedule

2024-2025



The City of Laurinburg collects residential curbside recyclable materials on a bi-weekly collection schedule. Each residence is assigned to either the **GREEN** or **RED** recycling route. This determines which week recyclables are collected according to the schedule below.

The recyclables will still be collected on the same day of the week as garbage. For example, if garbage collection day is on Monday, then recyclables collection will be every other Monday.

The City of Laurinburg **ONLY** collects the following items in the curbside recycling program:

- Plastic BOTTLES with #1 or #2 on bottom (empty and rinse)
- Corrugated Cardboard - Packaging Boxes; (broken down and flattened) No Pizza Boxes
- Aluminum Cans; Steel Cans; Clear, Brown, and Green glass bottles (empty and rinse)
- Used Motor Oil (secured in a plastic bottle (up to 1 gallon) and placed beside the recycling cart)
- Used Cooking Oil (secured in a plastic bottle (up to 1 gallon) and placed beside the recycling cart)
